Church Board Member At Large Job Description and Responsibilities from Church By-Laws

MEMBERSHIP	Section 1 - The Church Board shall be composed of the <i>Senior Pastor, Treasurer, Head Deacon, Chairmen</i> of the following Committees: <i>Grounds and Building, Worship, Christian Education, Missions, plus three (3) <u>Members At Large</u></i> Members of the Church Board shall be members of the local Church. Exceptions to this rule may be made with the approval of the District Superintendent.
DUTIES OF THE CHURCH BOARD	Section 4 - In addition to those duties outlined in the Constitution, it shall be the duty of the Church Board to: Arrange for all regular and special meetings of the Church; Engage necessary workers for the same; Approve the Church budget; Arrange for support of the Pastor and such other workers as may be engaged by the Board; Approve budgets of auxiliary organizations which would be of a continuing nature; Have prayerful and diligent oversight of the Church and its various ministries; Make such recommendations to the Church as may affect its general welfare; Delegate as it may deem wise and necessary its authority to carry out any of the above outlined duties; Appoint such subcommittees as may be needed to facilitate its functions.

Additional Expectations

- You will attend monthly meetings prepared to do the business of the church, (the church board usually meets the second Tuesday of the month.)
- You will attend specially called meetings (Sometimes the church board will have to meet at special times in order to handle immediate church business)
- You will regularly attend the worship services and educational ministries of the church.
- You will need to confer with people in the church regarding issues and ideas that the church board is considering.
- You will participate in church board discussions and willingly convey your thoughts, ideas and opinions.
- You will faithfully serve as the church board chairman requests (special assignments, reports, presenting devotionals and prayer, etc.)
